

Rule 1. (a)

- (i) An applicant for membership of the College of General Practitioners of Sri Lanka must be registered with the Sri Lanka Medical Council, under section 29 of the Medical Ordinance and should be practising in Sri Lanka. The application should be submitted to the Honorary Secretary of the College and the Censor Board of the Council of the College will scrutinise the application.
- (ii) An applicant for membership of the College who has -
- completed the MCGP Course and been successful at the MCGP Examination in conformity with the regulations in the MCGP Prospectus;
And
 - been engaged full time in general medical practice in the community or in a Department / Unit of Family Medicine at a University, continuously for a minimum period of three years, immediately before the date of application;
Or
 - been engaged part time in general medical practice in the community, continuously for a minimum period of five years, immediately before the date of application;
Or
Been engaged in general medical practice, in a Unit of the Ministry of Health or a Private Health Services institution, recognised by the Council of the Corporation, continuously for a minimum period of five years, immediately before the date of application;
And
 - shown commitment to the College of General Practitioners of Sri Lanka and the discipline of Family Medicine, by participating in activities of the College and continuing professional development as a general medical practitioner;
- Would be eligible for membership of the College by operation of Rule 1(a) (iii)
- (iii) An applicant for membership of the College of General Practitioners of Sri Lanka who is eligible, according to Rule 1(a)(ii), shall undergo a mandatory General Practice Mentoring Programme for a minimum of three months, prior to obtaining membership of the College.
- (iv) Diligent evaluation will be made to ascertain whether the prospective member will have the interests of the College in mind, work for and be loyal to the College.
- (v) The Censor Board having taken into consideration all aspects of the application and the recommendations of the committee will advise the Council on the suitability of the applicant for membership.
- (vi) The Council of the College will decide on whether or not the applicant should be made a member.
